Winemaker:

Our Winemaker Greg Bjornstad believes that care taken in the vineyard creates a beautiful wine in the bottle. His hands-on approach during the growing season is balanced by a philosophy of allowing the true characteristics of the terroir to express themselves with minimal intervention during winemaking.

Winemaker Notes:

Classic pink salmon in color with heady aromas of Rainer cherry, mandarin orange, cardamom, wild strawberry and violets that continue to the plush mid-palate of honeysuckle, mint, clove and vanilla. A stunning line of grapefruit keeps the mouth-feel lively and beautifully balanced through the long supple finish.

Technicals:

Brix at Harvest: Press 21.3 and Saignee averaged 22° brix

Harvest Dates: Press 8/21, Saignee through 9/16

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

Alcohol: 13.0%

Winemaking: 50/50 saignee and pressed whole clusters.

Inoculated and fermented in neutral French Oak. Racked, cold stabilized and

filtered 4/13

Cooperage: 8 months neutral French oak

Clone: Joseph Swan, Calera, Pommard &, 828
